- Applicants are required to undergo a certain period of training as a guide in order to qualify as a member of "Iwayuri". The period prior to membership qualification is a training period and unpaid.
- ◆ After the application period closes, a briefing session regarding the recruitment will be held, which you are cordially invited to attend. The briefing will be held at the Kamo Aquarium Lecture Room. The date and time will be announced at a later date.

About Kamo Aquarium Volunteers

If you are appointed as a volunteer guide, you will be a member of the Kamo Aquarium volunteer organization "Iwayuri". As a volunteer, you will be able to provide a wonderful experience for visitors to Kamo Aquarium, and your time as a guide will be invaluable to you.

You may be thanked by a visitor who says, "I wouldn't have understood anything if I hadn't listened to your explanation, and I'm glad I did. Or you may hear them say, "That was great!" or "I'll bring my grandchildren next time. I also get to witness the moment when a customer's eyes light up or a smile breaks out when I talk with them.

During the holiday season, 70 to 80% of Kamo Aquarium's visitors come from outside Yamagata Prefecture. If we can attract visitors from far away, it will help revitalize the local economy: if one tourist spends 20,000 yen, 100,000 people will spend 2 billion yen, and if 30,000 yen is spent, the economic impact will be 3 billion yen.

To help revitalize the local economy, we are looking forward to receiving applications from those who are interested in guiding tours of the jellyfish backstage, which is one of Kamo Aquarium's main attractions!

- The volunteer group "Iwayuri" was established in January 2000.
- The iwayuri, rock lily in English, is a plant that blooms orange flowers on coastal rocks and cliffs in early summer. It grows wild in abundance around Kamo Aquarium.
