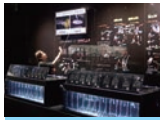

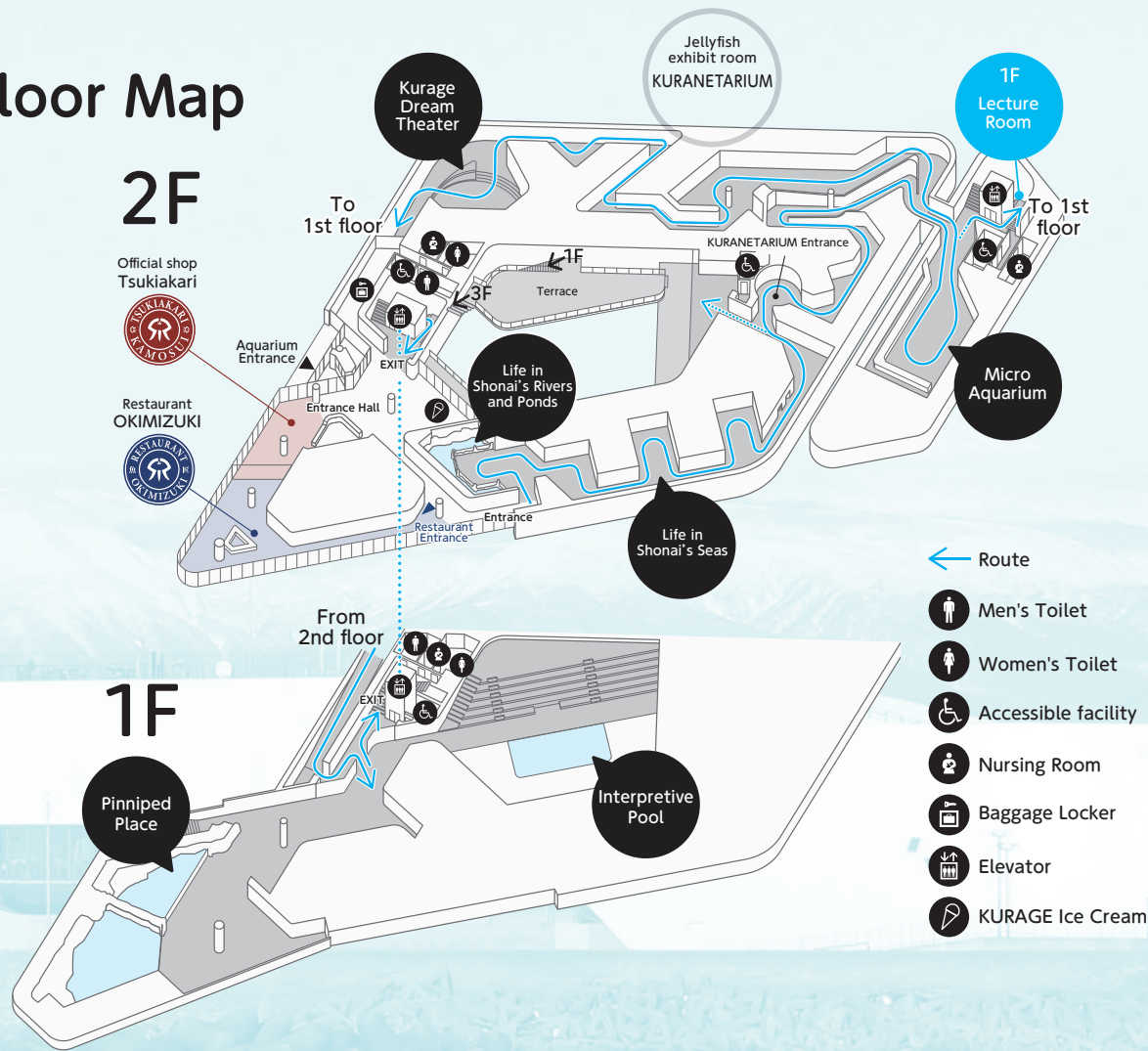

Some 100 different jellyfish species from around the world are on display at the world's largest jellyfish exhibit room. Experience the special calming effect of this magical space.



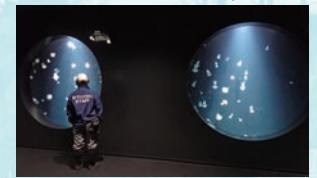

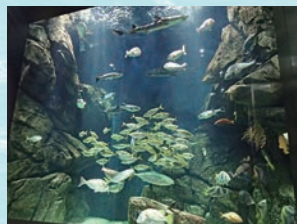

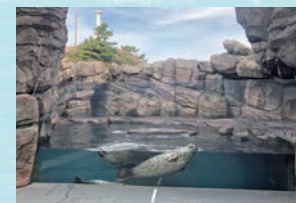
